Meeting Minutes  
14 October 2009

The meeting was convened by Dale Dallon at 7:00 pm with about 50 people attending. An exact count was not taken. We were honored, however, by the presence of Dale Nish, Mike Mahoney, Lane Phillips, Paul Chilton, and Joe Wagner. Kirk DeHeer and Stuart Davey were both out of town.

Dale announced that the Utah Woodturning Symposium will be held May 6-8, 2010. This year the symposium board will be broadening their use of volunteer staff in several areas of the symposium organization. They will be looking primarily to the membership of the Utah and Timp Woodturners Associations for those volunteers. The chartered purpose of our club is to increase awareness and interest in the wood-turning craft so our members are asked to give careful consideration to stepping forward to support this important symposium. Volunteers will be rewarded with free admission to the symposium. The club will be kept informed as more information becomes available concerning the nature and number of volunteer positions we will be asked to help fill.

Several students from Dale Nish's current basic class at Craft Supplies visited our meeting. One had come from as far as Hawaii. Five new members were introduced to the club: Vern Cahoon from Highland, Joe Ford from Lehi, Dave Greer from Provo, Bill Peugh from Cedar Hills, and Tom Ramage from Orem. We currently have 64 dues-paying members.

Dale Dallon presented a demonstration of his method of turning onion-top lidded boxes. Unfortunately, there was no photographer present and no video was made of the demonstration.
